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(Abruzzo): Bronze winner at Decanter awards with an expressive nose of peach, mango and candied rose petals, the wine has a long, full mineral-rich mouth. Grape variety: 100% Pecorino.

Lugana San Benedetto Zenato DOC, 13% (2017/8)				£33.95
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(Veneto): A delicate tasting wine with a delicate bouquet and a long, pure and refined finish. Grape variety: Trebbiano di Lugana.

Pinot Grigio Santa Margherita DOC, 12.5% (2018)				£35.95
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(Trentino / Alto Adige): Santa Margherita is the benchmark against which all other Pinot Grigio is measured. It is crisp, dry and refreshing with hints of citrus fruit. Grape variety: Pinot Grigio.

Verdicchio Del Castelli Di Jesi Superiore 'Vigna dell' Oche' San Lorenzo DOC 14% (2016)				£35.95
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(Le Marche): Lively on the palate with spicy notes, creamy fruit and brisk finish. Made from organic or biodynamic grapes with minimal intervention in the winery. Grape variety Verdicchio.

Fiano di Avellino, Tenuta Scotto DOCG, 13.5% (2017/8)				£37.95
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(Campania): A slightly restrained nose gives way to a ripe flavour nice length and richness on the palate but with elegance. A nicely structured wine. Grape: Fiano.

Greco di Tufo, Tenuta Scotto DOCG 13.5% (2017/8)				£37.95
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(Campania): Dry and fresh with hints of peach and dried apricot. On the palate it displays a certain richness and then a nicely balanced elegance. Grape variety: 100% Greco.

Sauvignon Collio 'Blanc Fumat' Collavini DOC, 12.5% (2017/8)				£37.95
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(Friuli / Venezia / Giulia): Dry, aromatic, intense tropical fruit on the nose and a long lasting lychee flavour on the palate. Grape variety: Sauvignon Blanc.

Pomino Frescobaldi DOC, 12.5% (2017/8)				£38.95
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(Tuscany): Dry, full & fragrant, like a top white burgundy. Grape variety: Chardonnay/Pinot Bianco.

Lintori Vermentino di Sardegna Capichera DOCG, 13.5% (2017)				£45.95
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(Sardinia): Fruity, fresh and flavourful with notes of citrus and minerals on the palate. This is a complex and well balanced wine with a lovely finish. Grape variety: 100% Vermentino.

Pinot Bianco Stralher, Stroblhof DOC, 13.5% (2017/8)				£52.95
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(Alto Adige): Beautifully fresh and finely-tuned with ripe and generous fruit tones. Elegant and harmonious. Grape variety: Pinto Bianco 94%, Pinot Grigio 6%.

Tasca Chardonnay, Vigna San Francesco DOC, 14% (2014)				£94.95
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(Sicily): One of the finest Italian white wines! Golden-yellow in colour, on the palate, this wine shows poise and presence; a rich and textured wine with a refreshing backbone of acidity that draws into a layered and lasting finish. Grape variety: Chardonnay. (Very limited availability).

(Tuscany): Full bodied, well balanced with juicy fruit notes, soft tannins and a long lingering finish. Grape variety: 90% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot.

(Veneto): Scents of blackberry, cherry and raspberry. On the palate it is very harmonious, fruity with a nice tannic structure. Grape Variety: Pinot Noir.

(Tuscany): Full-bodied and intense with hints of vanilla on the nose. Grape variety: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot

- Il Principe Rallo Nero d'Avola IGP 12.5% (2018)** **£31.95**
(Sicily): Cherries, blackcurrant and ripe red fruits. Grape variety: Nero d'Avola
- Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Colle Cavalieri Cantina Tollo DOP 13% (2018)** **£32.95**
(Abruzzo): Ruby red in colour with purple highlights. Small red berry fruits on the palate. Morello cherry and a delicate and spicy touch on the finish. Medium bodied, well structured with soft and well balanced tannins. Grape variety: 100% Montepulciano
- Chianti Classico San Jacopo di Vicchiomaggio DOCG, 13% (2016/7)** **£36.95**
(Tuscany): Elegant and smooth with red cherry and cranberry fruit on the palate. Grape variety: 90% Sangiovese, 5% Canololo, 5% Colorino.
- Norma Etna Rosso Valenti DOC 13% (2014/5)** **£37.95**
(Sicily): Aged for 8 months in oak and a further 4 months in bottle to produce a fine, light and elegant fresh tasting wine. Grape variety: 98 % Nerello Mascalese, 2% Nerello Cappuccio
- Salice Salentino Riserva Leone de Castris DOC 13.5% (2015/6)** **£39.95**
(Puglia): Velvet smooth wine with hints of dark fruit and liquorice, well balanced with a long finish. Grape variety: 90% Negroamaro, 10% Malvasia Nera di Lecce
- Montesu Isola dei Nuraghi Agricola Punica IGT, 14.5% (2016)** **£43.95**
(Sardinia): From the oenologist and the Tenuta San Guido estate behind the famous Super Tuscan "Sassicaia". Grape variety: 60% Carignano, 10% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot.
- Brolo Campofiorin Oro Masi IGT, 14% (2014/5)** **£45.95**
(Veneto): A double fermentation followed by 24 months in oak barrels results in a rich soft wine with a velvety finish. Grape variety: 80% Corvina, 10% Rondinella, 10% Oseleta.
- Rosso di Montalcino Col D'Orcia DOC, 14% (2015/6)** **£47.95**
(Tuscany): Bright ruby red, intense and very fine, with marked overtones of violet and blackberry with an elegant aftertaste. Organic Wine. Grape variety: Sangiovese.

- Governo all'Uso Toscano "Bosco del Grillo" Geografico IGT 13% (2016)** **£35.95**
(Tuscany): Reviving a 14th century Tuscan technique of a second fermentation by adding a small percentage of dried grapes produces an elegant wine with fruity scents and sweet tannins. Grape variety: 80% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Colorino
- Achelo, La Braccasca, Famiglia Antinori DOC 14% (Syrah) (2017)** **£41.95**
(Tuscany): Complex, pepper-and-tobacco nose, with a full, supple texture, and plum/blackberry fruit, as well as the typical spicy, herbal finish of Tuscany. Grape: Syrah.
- Scirè Rosso Ceralti, Bolgheri DOC 13.5% (2017)** **£44.95**
(Tuscany): Aged three months in oak. Soft with sweet tannins and fruity aftertaste. Grape variety: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot
- Le Difese Tenuta San Guido IGT 13% (2017)** **£44.95**
(Tuscany): The entry-level Super Tuscan from the makers of the world famous Sassicaia. Smooth, refreshing and deliciously balanced. Grape variety: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Sangiovese
- Vie Cave Fattoria Aldobrandesca Maremma IGT, 15% (2016)** **£47.95**
(Tuscany): From Antinori comes this Tuscan Malbec, which is rich and full-bodied with excellent density and persistence. Vino Biologico. Grape variety: 100% Malbec.

- Taurasi Tenuta Scuotto DOCG, 14% (2013)** **£53.95**
(Campania): Dry, warm, soft with great persistence with delicate and fine tannins. Grape variety: Aglianico di Taurasi .
- Le Volte, Tenuta Dell'Ornellaia IGT, 14% (2016/7)** **£54.95**
(Tuscany): Extremely well balanced "Super Tuscan" with a long refined finish. Grape: 50% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Sangiovese.
- Chianti Classico Riserva Villa Antinori DOCG 13% (2015/6)** **£55.95**
(Tuscany): This is a rich, modern Chianti which marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with smoky oak notes. Grape variety: 90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Barbaresco Autinbej Ca' del Baio DOCG, 15% (2015/6)** **£57.95**
(Piemonte): The color is a deep garnet red, the nose is an intense, fruity aroma. To taste this is a warm, long, persistent and slightly tannic with an aftertaste of fruity notes. Grapes: 100% Nebbiolo.
- il Bruciato Guado al Tasso DOC, 13.5% (2016/7)** **£59.95**
(Tuscany): Full bodied and smooth wine from Bolgheri with a long finish. Grape variety 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 15% Syrah.
- Cannonau Riserva Keramos, Tenute Soletta DOC 15% (2010/11)** **£59.95**
(Sardinia): Full-bodied with aromas of ripe plum, vanilla and a hint of charred topsoil. The warm, chewy palate has flavours of ripe black cherry, liquorice and coffee bean. Grape variety: Cannonau
- Soffocone di Vincigliata, Bibi Graetz 13% IGT (2017)** **£65.95**
(Tuscany): Hints of wild berries on the nose with a velvety silky texture on the palate. It has very elegant tannins with a long persistent finish. Grape variety: Sangiovese.
- Polvanera 16 Gioia del Colle Vigneto San Benedetto, 16% DOC (2014)** **£65.95**
(Puglia): Rich and full-bodied wine with tones of blackberry and black cherries. Grape variety: Primitivo.
- Alfeo Rosso Ceralti Bolgheri DOC 14.5% (2015/6)** **£65.95**
(Tuscany): Very smooth and elegant with rich ripe fruit. Grape variety: 60% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc.
- Barolo Essenze Riserva Terredavino Agricole DOCG, 14% (2008)** **£89.95**
(Piemonte): Dry, full-bodied, with silky tannins and a lovely chocolate, berry aftertaste. Gold medal winner at Decanter World Wine Awards 2015. Grape variety: Nebbiolo.
- Tasca Cabernet Sauvignon Tenuta Regaleali IGT 14.5% (2014/5)** **£95.95**
(Sicily): Ruby-red in colour with aromas of wild berries, vanilla and, cinnamon. Rich ripe fruit flavours on the elegant, balanced palate. Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Amarone Riserva di Costasera Masi DOCG, 15.5% (2013)** **£115.00**
(Veneto): Rich and soft on the palate with rich cherry and blueberry flavours and some sweet spice. Grape variety: 70% Corvina, 15% Rondinella, 10% Oseleta, 5% Molinara.
- Brunello di Montalcino CastelGiocondo DOCG, 14.5% (2014)** **£125.00**
(Tuscany): One of the most prestigious Italian wines. It is deep red, full and harmonious, with notes of forest berries. The taste is fulfilling & incredibly long. Grape variety: Sangiovese Grosso.
